JOB DESCRIPTION & PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the supervision of the CEO and Sales & Marketing manager, the DISTILLERY GUIDE will be required to ensure the highest levels of customer service by welcoming, informing and enthusing our visitors during their visit of the distillery, consistently delivering a memorable and enriching experience!

Main responsibilities include the following:

- Welcome day visitors and collect guests' information and tour payment.
- Lead the distillery visits by explaining the story and production process in an enthusiastic and interactive manner:
 - Interact with our guests to ensure they are having a great tour experience.
 - Ensure visitor safety during the visit.
- Organize and lead the tasting of our products by
 - Ensuring the bar remains clean as per the company's standards.
 - Interact with customers to assess customers' needs and preferences and make recommendations.
 - Mixing ingredients to prepare tasting and cocktails.
 - Restocking and replenishing bar inventory and supplies.
 - Complying with all food and beverage regulations.
- Assist the Retail shop manager/assistant when necessary

QUALIFICATIONS & COMPETENCES

- **Excellent communication skills in English**, written and verbal. Bilingual is a minimum and Trilingual is a strong advantage.
- **Contributes to building a positive team spirit** and work with colleagues to ensure the best experience is given to our visitor.
- **Outgoing and enthusiastic personality** and ability to speak to large groups.
