About CARE Vanuatu

CARE is an international humanitarian aid organisation fighting global poverty, with a special focus on working with women and girls to bring lasting change to their communities. As a non-religious and non-political organisation, CARE works with communities to help overcome poverty by supporting development projects and providing emergency assistance.

CARE international in Vanuatu has a focus on Gender Equality, Disaster Risk Reduction, Climate Change Adaptation, Agriculture and Water and Sanitation and Hygiene.

Project Context

As part of CARE's Gender Equality program, and with funding support from UNFPA and DFAT, CARE has been rolling out a respectful relationships curriculum (Good Relationships Free from Violence, GRFV) with youth and supporting Village Savings and Loans Associations (VSLAs) in villages in Tafea province. To support these workshops, CARE is looking for a consultant to assist with translating workshop materials into Bislama from English.

Purpose

The purpose of the assignment is:

- Review existing Bislama translation of some text and translate from English to Bislama remaining text for a handout for participants in the GRFV workshops (approximately 7,000 words)
- Translate from English to Bislama text for a VSLA Field Agent Handbook (approximately 22,500 words)
